

Menzies Doctoral Research Scholarships

The Menzies School of Health Research are offering scholarships to support PhD students involving the Aboriginal Birth Cohort Study: Wave-4 in the areas of nutrition and mental health

Eligibility:

- Enrolled in or satisfy the admission requirements to the Doctor of Philosophy program at Charles Darwin University
- Available to commence/enrol in Semester 1 2014
- Applicants research topic should align with Menzies research in the area of Nutrition or Mental Health
- Willingness to be based in Darwin at the Menzies School of Health Research for the majority of the candidature
- Ability to travel to remote Northern Territory communities for field-based research

Scholarship entitlements:

- Tax-free stipend of \$30,000 per annum (student will be expected to apply for a primary research scholarship in the first year of candidature)
- Student support funds to assist with project expenses such as travel and accommodation
