

Menzies' Renal Dialysis Educational Outcome Scholarship.

Thank you for your interest in applying for the **Menzies' Scholarship**. The Menzies School of Health Research is offering a scholarship to assist a Higher Degree by Research student to undertake a qualitative/quantitative study on Impact on urban schools and educational outcomes of children of adults relocated for medical treatment (dialysis) as part of funded research project. Menzies School of Health Research will select students using a competitive merit-based process.

These scholarships are for domestic students (Australian citizens and Permanent Residents) across Australia who are studying or intending to study a higher degree by research- full-time enrolled through Charles Darwin University commencing semester 1, 2017.

The scholarship will be offered for 1 year (subject to satisfying course academic requirements) and will include a tax free living stipend of \$30,000 pa. Scholarships stipends are paid fortnightly.

The Scholarship Panel will base their decisions on the following guidelines and criteria:

- a) Applicants will be ranked on academic merit.
- b) Careful consideration will be given to grade point average.
- c) Applicants should match have research interest in social science and public health: health and education
- d) Publications and relevant work experience will be considered where they bear direct influence on the applicant's academic or research capacity.
- e) An applicants ranking will not be affected by age.

Attendance at an interview is not required

To apply, please send the following:

- Scholarship Application Form (available from Caroline Sheridan)
- Research Proposal (400-600 words)
- Curriculum vitae
- Certified Transcripts for relevant undergraduate and postgraduate courses
- Reports from 2 Referees

An offer of a scholarship may be made prior to a student's confirmation of enrolment but such offers will be made on the condition that the student is eligible to receive a scholarship on the first census date for the scholarship period.
