

Hepatitis B app Privacy Policy - 2021

Menzies School of Health Research (ABN 70 413 542 847) (“Menzies”) is a charity registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission and is dedicated to improving the health and wellbeing of all Australians. Menzies built the app (SERVICE) for patients living with chronic hepatitis B (hep B) and their families. It tells the story of the hep B virus, how you get it, what happens over time, how you know you have it as well as details about immunisation and treatment (including a game). The app is available free of charge, there is no Commercial model or intent. This SERVICE is provided by Menzies and is intended for use as is.

This page is used to inform website visitors regarding our policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information if anyone decided to use our SERVICE.

If you choose to use our SERVICE as a USER, then you agree to the collection and use of information in relation to this policy. The Information that we collect is used only for providing, improving and evaluating the SERVICE. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy. We will not use or share information for advertising, marketing, or other purposes.

The terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions. We include a link to this privacy policy in the App Store Connect metadata field. This link is easily accessible to users.

Information Collection and Use

The app does not use third party services that may collect information used to identify you.

Log Data

We want to inform you that whenever you use our SERVICE, in a case of an error in the app we collect data and information (through third party products) called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your device Internet Protocol (“IP”) address, device name, operating system version, the configuration of the app when utilizing our SERVICE, the time and date of your use of the SERVICE, and other statistics.

Cookies

Cookies are files with a small amount of data that are commonly used as anonymous unique identifiers. These are sent to your browser from the websites that you visit and are stored on your device's internal memory.

This SERVICE does not use these “cookies” explicitly. However, the app may use third party code and libraries that use “cookies” to collect information and improve their services. You have the option to either accept or refuse these cookies and know when a cookie is being sent to your device. If you choose to refuse our cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of this SERVICE.
