IGC Mission

To ensure appropriate Indigenous community engagement, capacity building and knowledge translation.

To achieve this, Indigenous peoples '***ways of knowing being and doing***' needs to be integral to the way HOTH NORTH operates.

This will **guide** the way **research projects** are initiated, how they are conducted, how the research outcomes are transferred into policy and practice and how research is developed.

Roles of IGC

- Advise the ESG and investigators on individual research projects, including convening of relevant Indigenous project reference groups;
- Advise on Indigenous researcher training and capacity building approaches;
- Facilitate engagement with key local and national health organisations;
- Provide strategic advice and leadership to facilitate engagement, partnership and knowledge exchange across northern Australia.
- Ensure high level representation of umbrella Aboriginal Medical Service organisations in the three jurisdictions.
- Raise awareness of the work of HOT NORTH.
