






## **NEWSLETTER DECEMBER 2021**

## <u> August - November 2021</u>

- Engagement with individual Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Services (ACCHS) regarding the implementation of TKC or the outputs from the system is ongoing.
- In addition to all 56 government health services, 9 out of 13 ACCHS are now participating in TKC, which includes over 20 Aboriginal Medical Services.
- TKC versions 1.4.9, 1.4.10 & 1.4.11 were released. Some of the key features of 1.4.11 release are Include Medication Columns containing dosing instructions
  - Users on G70 accounts prompted to Logon with LAN access, increased security
  - Copy and paste function on synopsis report allows transfer to clinical work stations (CWS)
  - COVID Vaccination results from PCIS now more accurate
  - Dialysis Parameters included in new Communicare extract specific for Purple House
- TIC Plus (Territory Integrated Care Primary health data Linkage Using Software), which is focused on expanding the TKC system to include GP practices, has commenced with discussion on Data Participation Agreement with 3 private medical practices
- TKC Evaluation project has received ethics approval from all Top End and Central Australian sites as well as AMSANT. The final ACCHS approval is imminent with the evaluation commencing in phases next year.



## December 2021 - February 2022

TKC show and tell is now scheduled for February 2022. We will be providing a demonstration of the new features, discussing new functionalities as well as planning the future direction of the project.
