Randomisation

Once eligibility has been confirmed, a unique study number is used to identify the participant for the duration of the study. Randomisation occurs by the use of sealed, sequentially marked, opaque envelopes.

We stratify (allocate) by site, distress level and access to home dialysis aiming to have equal spread across the treatment groups.

Each participant is allocated to either early treatment, contact control/late treatment or treatment as usual /late treatment.
